

**MINUTES OF SECOND HEARING**  
**AQUATIC WEED CONTROL SPECIAL ASSESSMENT DISTRICT**

The second hearing for the Aquatic Weed Control Special Assessment District was called to order by Supervisor Stormont on Wednesday, December 17<sup>th</sup>, 2008 at 7:00 p.m. at the Township Hall. Board members Clark, Bray and Lesinski present. Absent: Loveland, Hart, Adams. Also present: Assessor DeBoe and 10 public.

Steve Hanson from Professional Lake Management, spoke in regard to the process for treating the mufoil. In 2009 they will be collecting all of the information as to the locations of mufoil offshore and in residential areas as well as in the lake and they will target the worst areas.

In 2010 they will be doing the whole lake, water quality monitoring, transparency readings and taking samples of nutrients.

Supervisor asked for comments or questions from public present. Clair Griffin then stated that he has no property on the lake, nor any lake access but was put on the special assessment district. Supervisor and Clerk will recheck his properties.

Being no other questions or comments, Supervisor Stormont then adjourned the public hearing at 8:00 p.m.

Supervisor then called the Special Meeting to order immediately following the closing of the public hearing.

Moved by Stormont that we accept the petitions that we have on file, supported by Bray. Motion carried by voice vote.

Moved by Bray to accept the estimated figures of \$ 71,012 for the 5 year special assessment district, with 2009 estimated cost of \$ 25,275.00 with special assessment per owner for 2009-2013 being \$ 200.00 per year, supported by Lesinski. Motion carried by voice vote.

Lesinski then offered the Resolution to "Create a Special Assessment District for Aquatic Weed Control in Grass Lake" with cost to be assessed to land and premises within the district, supported by Bray. Roll Call: Yeas; Lesinski, Bray, Clark, Stormont. Absent: Loveland, Hart, Adams.

Moved by Lesinski to adjourn, supported by Bray. Special Meeting adjourned at 8:30 p.m.
