

## APPROVED WORK SESSION MINUTES

The Grass Lake Charter Township Board met on Tuesday, March 27, 2012 at 8:35 a.m. for their monthly work session. Board members Stormont, Clark, Loveland, Bray, Hart, Adams, Jr. present. Absent: Lesinski Also present: Assessor DeBoe

Discussion was held on the following:

- Resolution regarding the “Aquatic Weed Control Deficit Elimination Plan” that has to be sent to the State Treasury.
- Assessor DeBoe asking to change her hours at the Township office to Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday. Would be available at home but not be at the office on Thursday.
- Payment of wages to Board of Review, Planning Commission and Zoning Board of Appeals members when attending seminars or training.
- 2012 is election year for the Township Board members. Petitions have to be picked up from the Clerk and returned to the Clerk before May 14<sup>th</sup>. Persons wishing to run for a Township office will be on the August 7<sup>th</sup> Primary election.
- The guidelines for demolition of buildings under the “Dangerous Building” ordinance looks okay to members present.
- Boy Scouts who will be working on the trails, putting in a boardwalk, will bring in detailed plans before they start any work.
- The Township dashboard has been prepared by BS&A.
- Sale of lawn equipment will be ready for April 14<sup>th</sup>.
- Garry Gitcho has resigned from Board of Review, Zoning Board of Appeals and Hearing Officer positions. Therefore, we need to be looking names of persons to replace these positions.
- Supervisor has received word that a couple of ball teams that have been using the fields for practice have been misusing the fields.
- The Ganton project on East Michigan Avenue intends to brake ground within a couple weeks.
- Township Parking lot needs seal coating, we have a drainage problem on the east side of the lot that needs attention before doing seal coating.
