Tennis Courts – Lesinski stated that the cost to repair the tennis courts would be between \$45,000.00 to \$100,000.00. Lesinski and Zenz will look into the history of obligation of the Township if any for the repair and up keep of the courts.

ARPA Money – A plan needs to get put together as to how the money will be spent.

Lesinski asked for the board to help out more with ongoing projects he has on the table. Mostly, attending the numerous meetings and reporting back to the full board.
